INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE CERTIFICATE  
& INSTRUCTIONS INFORMATION

Drass releases an international warranty of 2 years on its watches, valid since the purchase date.

The warranty is valid only if the warranty certificate has been duly filled out by the reseller during the purchase.

The warranty certificate must indicate the name and model number, serial number, and the purchase date and place.

The warranty covers any defect due to faulty parts or a manufacturing defect.

For any maintenance or repair intervention, your watch must be sent only to one of our stores or to the authorised reseller, or it must be sent to the closest assistance centre which can be found in the relative list.

The warranty does not cover:

- the substitution of the battery
- damages or defects due to accident, improper use or negligence
- damages due to the normal wear of the box, strap and buckle, of the crown or glass
- the normal wear and aging of all natural materials
- a use of the watch not in compliance with the general recommendations indicated in the following page.



## General recommendations

You shall follow these instructions in order to be fully satisfied with your watch for many years:

- Avoid placing the watch nearby devices that generate significant magnetic fields.
- Avoid as much as possible any collision that could damage the watch or alter the motion.
- Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures or temperature variations (solar rays, halogen spotlights, etc).
- Avoid the direct contact with solvents, detergents, perfumes, mosquito repellents or any chemical substance, since they can damage the components of the watch.
- If the indication "WATER RESISTANT" appears at the bottom, the impermeability of the watch was tested for a pressure of at least 31,4 ATM



Nonetheless, the absolute impermeability of the watch cannot be always guaranteed. It can indeed be prejudiced by the aging of the sealing, by an accidental collision of the crown and glass and by other external factors.

- Make sure that the crown is always in the normal load position to prevent humidity or dusts from penetrating in the box.

- Do not handle the crown and the buttons of the chronographs under water to prevent this from penetrating in the box.

Use water with soap and a soft brush to clean metal, ceramic or PVD wristbands, straps in rubber, acetate or GG plus and water-proof boxes.

Rinse with clean water to eliminate the washing residues. Never use cleaning products. Rinse with a soft cloth.

- Always rinse the watch with warm water if it is used in saline or chlorinated environment (sea water, swimming pool).



Discharged or consumed batteries can melt, damaging the motion and the internal components of the watch. The battery shall be replaced every 18 months.

### Protection of the environment

Consumed batteries and components of the watch must not be thrown in the garbage but they must be recycled properly. They should be brought to the sales point. Consumed batteries and components of the watch must be recycled in compliance with national applicable laws.

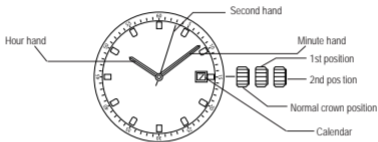
### Natural materials

Straps in leather, fabric and natural materials: since these materials are natural, be careful to protect the strap from an extended exposure to the sun and humidity in order not to alter the shape and colour. Avoid contact with water. Pearl dial, parts in natural materials: the characteristics of the natural materials highlight their structure and irregularities, thus rendering each piece unique and exclusive.

## B) SETTING THE TIME

1. Pull the crown out to the 2nd position.
2. Turn the crown to set hour and minute hands.
3. When the crown is pushed back to the normal position, small second hand begins to run.



### C) SETTING THE DATE

1. Pull the crown out to the 1st position.
2. Turn the crown counter-clockwise to set the date.  
\*If the date is set between the hours of around 9:00 PM and 1:00 AM, the date may not change on the following day.
3. After the date has been set, push the crown back to the normal position.



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
